Test Your Smoke Alarm Day is an initiative, most prominent in Ontario, Canada, that occurs annually on September 28th to encourage residents to test their smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. The day was established by Ontario's Fire Marshal, Jon Pegg, to address a significant rise in fire fatalities and promote home fire safety. On this day, people are encouraged to press the test button on their alarms, check their expiration dates, and practice their home fire escape plans to ensure safety.
